



# UNDERSTANDING FACTORS THAT IMPACT YOUR ENERGY BILLS

Energy bills are a significant part of household expenses, and understanding the factors that influence them can help you manage and potentially reduce your costs.

Various elements, from weather patterns to personal habits, play a role in determining the amount you owe each month.

When you receive your monthly bill from Clark Electric Cooperative, you're provided with a summary of how much electricity you used during the billing cycle. When you utilize SmartHub, you can even see how electricity use may have spiked on days, and even hours, when you used more electricity, such as a particularly chilly day or when relatives were staying with you to help identify usage patterns.

But you might be surprised to learn that beyond your monthly energy consumption, there are numerous external factors that can impact the cost of electricity.

## Fuel Prices

The cost of energy itself is a crucial factor. Clark Electric Cooperative purchases electricity from our power generation and transmission partner, Dairyland Power Cooperative. The cost of generating and transmitting electricity from our generation partner accounts for approximately 70% of the cost to provide electric service. MISO, the electric grid operator for the central United States, is a power market where prices can fluctuate, based on supply and demand, which in turn impacts the cost of electricity. We work closely with Dairyland Power Cooperative to plan ahead and help stabilize electricity prices for our members.

## Extreme Weather

While we can't control the weather, we can review weather patterns and forecasts to prepare for times of extreme cold or heat, when we know the demand for electricity will increase. But when temperatures become extremely cold and the demand for electricity spikes, the price of electricity can also increase. Understanding seasonal variation can help you anticipate changes in your energy bills.

## Home Insulation and Efficiency

The efficiency of your home's insulation, windows, and doors directly impacts your energy consumption. Poor insulation allows heat to escape in the winter and enter in the summer, making your HVAC system work harder. Upgrading insulation, sealing leaks, and installing energy-efficient windows can significantly reduce energy usage and costs.

## Appliances and Electronics

Older or inefficient appliances consume more energy

than newer, energy-efficient models. Refrigerators, washing machines, dryers, and dishwashers are some of the biggest energy consumers in a household. Additionally, electronics left plugged in or on standby mode can draw power continuously. Investing in Energy Star-rated appliances and unplugging devices when not in use can lead to savings.

## Household Habits

Your daily habits and lifestyle choices also affect energy consumption. Simple actions like turning off lights when leaving a room, using programmable thermostats, and taking shorter showers can add up to significant savings over time. Educating everyone in the household about energy conservation can make a noticeable difference.

## Home Size and Occupancy

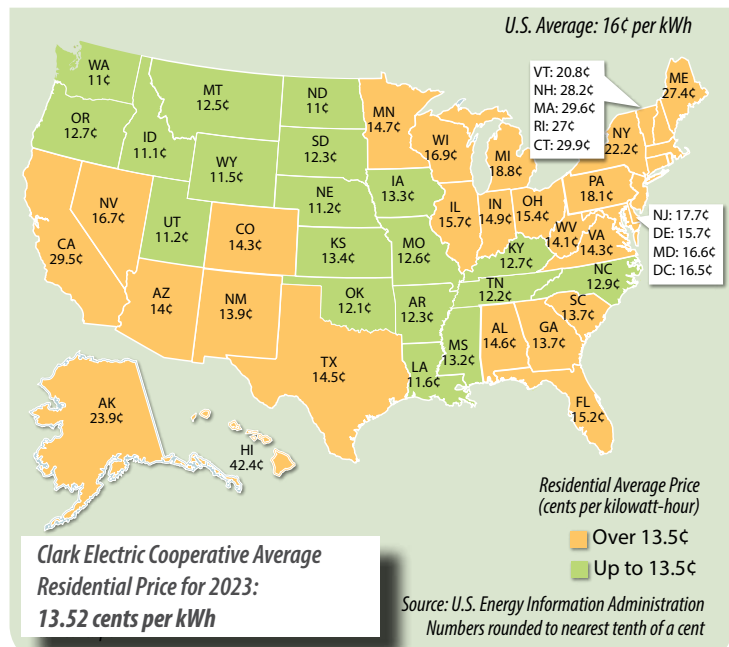
Larger homes generally require more energy to heat and cool. Similarly, the number of occupants affects energy use—more people typically mean more hot water usage, laundry, and cooking, all of which increase energy consumption. Understanding the relationship between home size, occupancy, and energy use can help you identify areas for improvement.

## Infrastructure, Equipment and Inflation

To cover the costs associated with providing electricity to

2023 figures, in cents per kWh



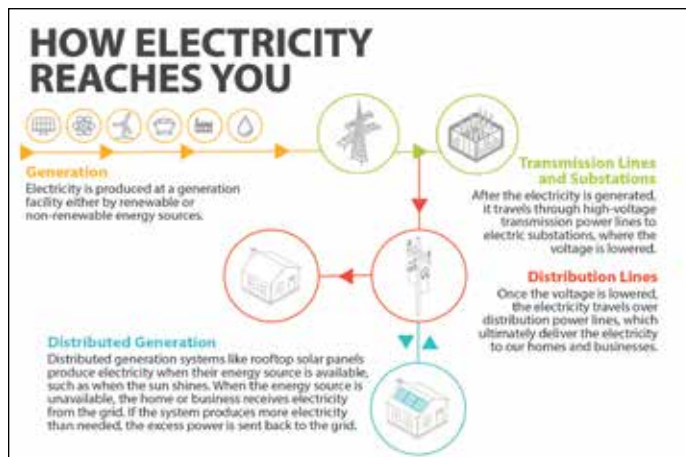
your home or business, Clark Electric Cooperative members pay a monthly fixed charge. This flat monthly fee ensures the cost of equipment, materials, labor and daily operations are covered for all members in our service area. To ensure the reliable service you expect and deserve, we must maintain the local grid, including power lines, substations and other essential equipment. Maintaining the local grid is expensive. Inflation continues to impact every sector of our economy, and the energy sector is no exception.

## Energy Policy and Regulations

Federal energy policies and regulations can have a profound impact on electricity costs. As energy generation shifts to the use of more renewable sources and stricter regulations for traditional, always-available fuel sources, such as natural gas and coal plants, costly upgrades and technologies must be constructed and deployed. These additional costs are ultimately passed to consumers. U.S. power consumption is expected to double by 2050.

## You Have Control

While many of these external factors that impact electricity costs are out of our control, we all have the power to manage our energy use at home. The most effective way to lower use is thermostat management. Since heating and cooling account for a major portion of home energy use, adjusting the thermostat



to the lowest comfortable setting can help you save energy and money. Remember to service your heating and cooling system annually and replace dirty filters as needed.

You can also reduce energy use by taking advantage of off-peak periods, when the demand for electricity is lower. Reserve energy-intensive chores for off-peak times, such as early in the morning or later in the evening, to save energy. Be sure to seal air leaks around windows, doors and other areas where gaps are possible. This will help your heating and cooling system work less and improve the overall comfort of your home.

When I became the Administrative Assistant, I was a little hesitant to take on the duties as outlined to assist the CEO/GM with reports for the Board meeting preparations and HR/Employee Benefits. As usual in the cooperative fashion, I received training and support to achieve my goals.

I have had the opportunity to meet and collaborate with employees from other cooperatives through the years. These contacts are essential in a cooperative industry where we wear many different hats to accomplish goals for all members.

I have enjoyed working for the members, with the employees, the past and current CEO/General Manager, and current and past Board of Directors over the years.

I have plans to travel more, spend time with my friends and family, and just see what new adventures come my way in my retirement.”
