



MISO ISSUES MAX GENERATION EVENT AMID WIDESPREAD WINTER STORM

Winter Storm Fern unleashed extreme cold weather and heavy snow across most of the Midwest and East Coast at the end of January. In our region, below-normal low temperatures coupled with unplanned power plant outages (due to weather or maintenance) and low wind generation strained grid reliability for the Midcontinent Independent System Operator (MISO). Reduced power supply and increased demand for power meant significantly higher energy prices. The Midcontinent Independent System Operator (MISO) issued a “Max Gen” event aimed at protecting the electrical grid. In addition to the extreme cold, higher than forecasted load and forced generation outages resulted in MISO declaring the Maximum Generation Event Step 2c/Energy Emergency Alert Level 2 on Saturday, January 24. When a Max Gen Event is declared, MISO is signaling that the regional grid is at an increased risk of not being able to


provide enough power to meet consumer needs. By issuing the Max Gen Event, MISO was able to call upon additional resources to help balance electricity supply and demand. In addition, Clark Electric Cooperative was alerted that we may be called upon to exercise our Emergency Load Reduction Plan to help keep the grid stable. (This is a plan that reduces demand on the system to help balance supply). Fortunately, this did not have to be exercised.

As all of this was occurring, our wholesale power provider Dairyland Power Cooperative – was unable to utilize one of its primary “baseload” power plants due to an unplanned maintenance outage. Baseload refers to a facility that can operate consistently and, when needed, bring stability to the grid. Baseload plants most commonly are powered by coal, natural gas or nuclear energy, while intermittent generating resources, like wind and solar, may only be available at certain times (when the sun shines and

the wind blows). This forced Dairyland to purchase power at higher prices than budgeted from the regional power market (MISO) further compounding the problem. As a result, actual wholesale power costs for January were considerably higher than forecast, thus significantly increasing the cost to Clark Electric Cooperative, which in turn will impact the cost of electricity.

Throughout the event, the majority of Dairyland’s other generation resources and load management tools contributed to grid stability, avoiding further cost escalations. Had the generation resources not been available, electricity prices would be more severe. Additionally, the cooperatives load management program performed well to further reduce demand on the system.

Preliminary data shows that Dairyland Power Cooperative may have set a new winter peak record during this period of extreme cold. At the most critical point of the frigid storm, MISO data




Clark Electric Cooperative is a distribution cooperative that receives power from Dairyland Power Cooperative, a generation and transmission (G&T) cooperative headquartered in La Crosse, Wis. Clark Electric Cooperative is a member-owner of Dairyland, just like Clark Electric Cooperative members are member-owners of Clark Electric. As a G&T, Dairyland is part of the MISO (Midcontinent Independent System Operator), which is one of seven regional transmission organizations (RTOs) in the United States. MISO was created in 1998 to provide safe, cost-effective delivery of electric power across all or parts of 15 U.S. States and the Canadian province of Manitoba. Through MISO, Dairyland sells the power it generates and purchases power it needs for its members. shows wind and solar provided about 3% of the energy, while natural gas, coal, and nuclear provided the bulk of the load. (See graph at right.)

This is not the way we anticipated beginning 2026. This event reminds us that power prices are volatile and subject to weather. Our wholesale power provider, Dairyland Power Cooperative, is committed to a diversified resource portfolio and enhanced transmission infrastructure to help mitigate financial impacts. As a not-for-profit electric cooperative, we set our rates at a level that will absorb some price fluctuation or storm repairs without charging our members more than is necessary. To date, we have been meeting with Dairyland since the end of January to discuss the most sustainable ways to address increased



power costs and mitigate the impact of the Winter Storm Fern on our membership as much as possible.

CO-OP LEADERS GATHER IN MADISON FOR EDUCATION AND LOBBY DAYS

Electric cooperative leaders gathered in Madison for WECA's Education and Lobby Days event, which took place January 25-26 in Madison.
